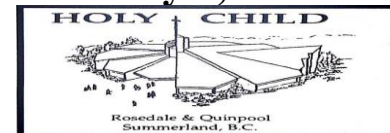

Supporting our Eritrean Family

As you are aware, the focus for Development and Peace this past Lent was supporting displaced persons around the world. Here at home, Yemane and his family have nearly reached their 1 year anniversary in Canada and Summerland. We are so blessed to have them as members of our church community. One of the last steps in the settlement process is to help the family secure reliable transportation. As well, unlike previous refugee families who have settled in Canada over the last 3 years, the government is returning to their previous policy of requiring families to repay their costs associated with travel to Canada. For Yemane's family that is a \$10,000 bill. Thanks to the incredible generosity of one of our parishoners, the family has been given a 7 passenger van. The van is in great shape but will need some repairs. The Summerland Refugee Sponsorship Society has begun a fundraising campaign to help defray all these costs for Yemane's family.
