Scripture.

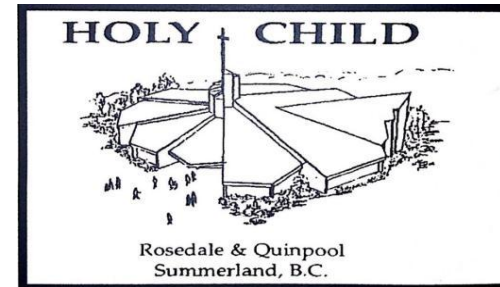
