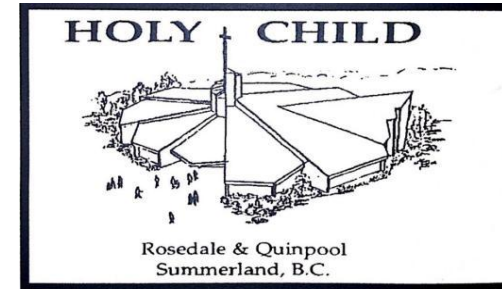
Exploring the Faith Discussion Group
