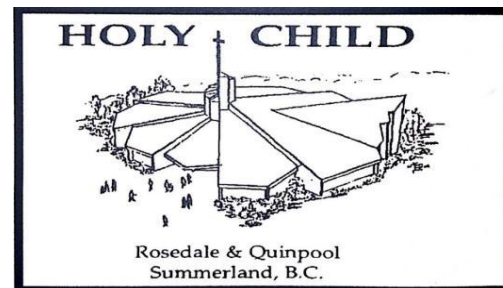
COUPLES FOR CHRIST
